Dr. M.S.Biradar, a visionary, the flag bearer of knowledge and wisdom, not just stood in moments of comfort and convenience but through times of challenges. It's a memorable moment for me to recollect how dear he was to me as a father figure. I greatly appreciate the care and warmth he showed in all phases of my life. I cannot express my feelings or describe his personality, nor can I endure his absence. Every time I try to recollect or try to pen down my feelings I end up with teary eyes. I was blessed to have the opportunity of working closely with him and acquiring knowledge under his guidance, admiring his dedication and keen interest in teaching and betterment of academics.

I consider myself fortunate to have worked under his leadership in the same unit for 20 long years and feel so proud to have been led forward by a man with incredible leadership skills. Saying 'thank you' is not enough for me to express how grateful I am for his support over the years. He was my MENTOR, a great boss whose words of encouragement and advice kept me sane while chasing deadlines. He stands as an important person in my life who shaped my teaching skills, observation and communication. He was a great inspiring teacher. I can personify sir as a phoenix that ignites brightness in the dark, spreading his strong vibes of excellence.

He was a genius, a gifted practitioner and a valuable gift to the society. His commitment towards his profession was remarkable. His profound knowledge was the main source of his academic personality. Besides knowledgeable information, he imparted moral values, vitalization of approach and deep sense of understanding. His talks, his smile, his devotion and deep interest for the poor and needy were admirable. Dr M.S.Biradar, whose roots were from rural background, by his own un-aided efforts had reached success and earned name and fame.

He strived hard and strengthened his abilities as an able administrator. I really admired his work ethics and administrative skills as an administrator myself. It is not so easy to face the challenges and the stress which he managed efficiently. He stands as a benchmark till this very day. He was the backbone of our institute. He had an ideal image of a possible and desirable future life the organization striving for its excellence, which resulted in the increase of undergraduate seats to 200, and acquiring prestigious NAAC 'A' grade accreditation. He accelerated the institute's progress by incorporating his innovative ideas, giving importance to higher and speciality courses. I closely observed his creative ways of solving problems. He never failed to maintain the absolute integrity and devotion to duty. He strongly followed his belief "Kayakavekailasa", and preached the same to his students and fellow colleagues.

He was so passionately immersed in teaching that he never used to see the time while teaching or while attending meetings which reflected his deep involvement. He was master in all fields with a quest for current affairs. Being a keen observer, he had travelled to more than 50 countries, learning, observing their work culture, ethics and incorporating the best in himself and to the institute. He was an ideal strict teacher, who commanded respect and obedience, and also a friend when needed. We shared mutual

respect and trust which formed the base for the lasting relationship I shared with him. Above all, his sense of humor made an everlasting impact on all.

He was a great teacher who had the ability to forge a positive, powerful relationship between a student and a teacher. He was able to understand the problems of his students and fellow colleagues and had his own style of interaction and communication. He shared a special bond with students by consistently displaying parity among students which instilled mutual respect, and ushered in positivity. The bond he shared with students was infused with equal doses of discipline and affection that went beyond the classroom and textbooks.

Above all, he was the great human being who lived in this world and I pray the Almighty bless this world by sending such noble souls. Words fail to describe him. Though he is not physically present, his morals, values and ethics will always be 'MY GUIDING LIGHT'.
