
National Workshop on Bibliometric Analysis

Session I: Conceptualization of Bibliometric Analysis and Related Theories

Resource Person: Dr. Gururaj S. Hadagali

The National Librarians Day and Workshop on Bibliometric Analysis commenced on 11th August 2023 with an insightful session led by Dr. Gururaj S. Hadagali. He elucidated the various dimensions of bibliometric analysis, including Bibliomatric, Scientometric, Librametric, and Webmatrics, along with an exploration of associated laws and theories. The attendees were provided with a comprehensive understanding of the theoretical foundations that underpin bibliometric studies.

The afternoon of Day 1 continued with a hands-on workshop on the Sci 2 software conducted by Prof. K Sateesh Kumar. Participants were guided through the software's functionalities and learned how to utilize it for bibliometric analysis. The interactive session allowed attendees to gain practical experience in employing the Sci 2 tool effectively.



Prof. K Sateesh Kumar further engaged the participants with a practical session on the Pajek software. This session provided insights into network analysis and visualization techniques, empowering attendees to harness the potential of Pajek for their bibliometric research endeavours.

BMJ AUTHOR WORKSHOP: Write to Publish


The BMJ Author Workshop: Write to Publish was a resounding success, with over 250 PG students, researchers, and faculty members participating. The event was inaugurated by Prof. MB Patil, the Vice Principal of the institution, and Prof. MM Patil, the Director of the Research and Development Cell, who highlighted the significance of research and publication in medicine. Dr. Prasanna Kumar BM, the University Librarian, served as the workshop coordinator

The resource person for the workshop was Dr. Simi Kaul, Senior Clinical EditorBMJ India. Dr. Kaul is a highly experienced editor and has published numerous papers in peer-reviewed journals. She has also taught and mentored many young researchers on how to write and publish their work.

During the workshop, Dr. Kaul covered various topics related to scientific writing and publication. She began by discussing how to choose a topic for a research paper. She emphasized the importance of selecting an interesting and feasible topic. She also advised participants to consider the target audience for their paper when choosing a topic. Next, Dr. Kaul discussed how to structure a research paper. She explained the different sections of a research paper and how to write each section effectively. She also provided tips on how to write a clear and concise introduction, methods, results, discussion, a conclusion.Dr. Kaul then discussed how to write clear and concise prose. She emphasised the importance of using simple language and avoiding jargon. She also advised participants to proofread their work carefully before submitting it. In the workshop's final session, Dr. Kaul discussed formatting references and citations and submitting a manuscript to a journal. She provided participants with a detailed overview of the different referencing styles and how to use them correctly. She also explained the journal submission process and provided tips on how to write a successful cover letter. The workshop was very well-received by the participants. They appreciated the opportunity to learn from an experienced editor and receive tips on writing and publishing their work. Many participants commented that they found the workshop informative and helpful.
